A Hands-on Approach to Geography

Introduction

If a survey is conducted among school students to find out their favorite subject, it is likely that Geography will be at the very bottom of the list, or may not figure in the list at all! Well, that's how most of us reading this brochure might have felt when we were in school...

Reading every line from the text book, marking answers, copying them first in the class work book and then copy the same answers in the home work book... what an ordeal! Especially, when the child is not able to make any sense from what she/he is copying. That's not all. Then come the exams with short answers and long answers... how can one remember them all?

Content

The concept – *place* – deals with the physical as well as the human characteristics of a place.

You can go back to your classroom with teaching ideas that are easy to use and most importantly, ideas that work!
